Through training in prevention, detection and response our policies and practices provide great assistance in completing the elimination of such acts.

The SCSD may redact specific material from this and future PREA reports when the publication would present a clear and specific threat to the safety and security of the facility. Any redacted material must have a general statement to indicate that the material has been removed from the report.

Aggregated Data on Sexual Abuse Allegations and Comparison to Prior Use

Only after a full investigation are events defined as PREA violation or otherwise (i.e., consensual but unauthorized sexual activity that does not qualify as PREA).
